

**TOWN OF LINN, WALWORTH COUNTY,  
WISCONSIN, DECLARING A SNOW EMERGENCY**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 9-5(d)(4)(b) of the municipal code, I declare a Snow Emergency exists in the Town of Linn, Walworth County, WI, until 12:00 p.m. on Saturday, December 24, 2022; and

**WHEREAS**, according to the National Weather Service, a combination of strong winds and snow is expected until December, 23, 2022, and arctic air and bitterly cold wind chills until December 24, 2022; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to sections 323.11 and 323.14(4)(b) of the Wisconsin Statutes it is necessary and expedient for the health, safety, welfare and good order of the Town to proclaim that emergency conditions exist; and

**WHEREAS**, the disaster has resulted in hazardous outdoor and road conditions, which will continue to cause longer times for roadways to be cleared, and some roads to be impassable; and

**WHEREAS**, no person shall park or leave standing any vehicle on any street to avoid interference with snow removal operations; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Linn requests Walworth County, WI, to advise the State of Wisconsin of our emergency conditions, and may request for county assistance:

**NOW, THEREFORE**, pursuant to sections 323.11 and 323.14 (4) of the Wisconsin Statutes, I hereby declare a condition of disaster due to snow, and excessively cold and windy conditions until 12:00 p.m. on December 24, 2022.
