AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE TOWN OF LINN, WALWORTH COUNTY, WISCONSIN, SECTION 13-11(D)(5)(B), PIER PERMIT AS-BUILT SURVEY

§ 13-11 Wharves, piers, slips and buoys.

- D. Wharf, pier and boat slip permit required.
- (5) Revocation of permit.
- (a) In the event that the wharf, pier or boat slip for which a permit has been granted is not erected, constructed, placed, extended or maintained in accordance with the application, plans, specifications, details and drawings submitted by the applicant thereof, or in the event that such wharf, pier or boat slip is erected, constructed, placed, extended or maintained in violation of any of the provisions of this section or any applicable laws of the State of Wisconsin or rules or orders of the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources, the governing body of the municipality in which such structure is located may revoke said permit after holding an evidentiary hearing on the alleged violation. A written notice of the time, date and place of said evidentiary hearing, together with a summary of the alleged violation, shall be mailed, by certified mail, to the holder of said permit at least 10 days prior to the date of the hearing thereon. If the permit is revoked, the reasons therefor shall be stated in the minutes of the meeting of the governing body.

(b)

Ninety days following completion of the pier, the applicant shall submit an as-built survey completed by a certified surveyor along with a photograph depicting the completed project to the Building Inspector. At minimum, the as-built survey must include the pier length, pier width, and riparian setbacks. Any person who violates any of the provisions of this Subsection shall be subject to a forfeiture per the Town of Linn Fee Schedule.
